CS & CE MSDNAA Software

Student licenses are available <u>free</u> to students currently enrolled in a course taught by the Computer Science Department at Harding University.

What Software?

All Microsoft Development Tools and Operating Systems are available. Microsoft Office is NOT available.

How do I get access?

To get the software you must agree to and sign a Student Use Agreement contract. *Each student must sign a new Student Use Agreement each semester.*

Option #1: Install using the network.

Installations for some of the more popular software titles are available on the computer science departmental server, "cs1". To get access to the folder containing the software you must have signed a Student Use Agreement contract. Signed contracts should be delivered to the Computer Science department in room 100 in the Science building.

After your Student Use Agreement has been received and processed, you will be granted access to the CS1 server. You may then open the network share: \\cs1\msdnaa\) and download the desired software. Some products will require a license key before installation can be completed. The required keys are free and may be obtained by contacting Dr. Baber (office: Science 100; phone: 279-4266).

The network share is only available while on Harding's campus. If requested, enter your username as "harding\username".

Option #2: Download CD Images from network.

ISO CD images of some of the more popular software titles are available on the computer science department server, "cs1". To get access to the folder containing the CD images you must have signed a Student Use Agreement contract. Signed contracts should be delivered to the Computer Science department in room 100 in the Science building.

After your Student Use Agreement has been received and processed, you will be granted access to the CS1 server. You may then open the network share: \(\lambda \text{L\msdnaa}\) and copy the CD images ("iso" files) to your computer. You will need to use CD-burner software to burn a copy of the iso images onto a CD-R, CD-RW, or DVD-R disk. Some products will require a license key before installation can be completed. The required keys are free and may be obtained by contacting Dr. Baber (office: Science 100; phone: 279-4266).

The network share is only available while on Harding's campus. If requested enter your username as harding\username.

Option #3: Purchase Media (Microsoft Originals)

A limited number of CD's are available for purchase at cost. Contact the departmental secretary in Science 100 if you would like to make a purchase. Some products will require a license key before installation can be completed. The required keys are free and may be obtained by contacting Dr. Baber (office: Science 100; phone: 279-4266).
