An Art Summer Abroad is highly recommended. Ask about the Department of Art and Design's overseas summer options. Check with your advisor to learn about current plans and anticipated course offerings.

BFA VAS degree requirements include:

Art core courses (54 hrs/ BFA_C), a major concentration area (15hrs/ BFA_M), and a secondary emphasis (9hrs/ BFA_2)

Courses required by Harding's Liberal Arts Program or for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Visual Arts Studio are detailed in the Harding Catalog, <http://www.harding.edu/catalog/>

Art101/THEA 101/ MUS 101 Liberal Arts requirement NOT required for this degree.

** this course, or an equivalent, is often available during Harding's semesters abroad (HUF, HUG, HULA, HUE, etc.) See Catalog "International Studies", esp. HUM270/275/280. Therefore, if you are considering attending a semester abroad, you may want to NOT take these courses beforehand. Discuss these details with your advisor.

*** HUF and HUG offer KINS activity courses. Other overseas sites sometimes do. (so take this course overseas if you can)

Note that Liberal Arts requirements (Lib Arts) may, in general, be taken during any semester in any order, with few exceptions.

You will take a Bible course (8 required, including Art 375) and have Chapel during every semester.

**** GLOBAL LIT: Any modern foreign language courses; ANTH 250; BIOL 250; BMIS 280, 386, 387, 388; GEOG 302, 303; HNRS 204, 205; HUM 201; POLS 202; SOCS 301. (etc. Check HU catalog)

Explore the Global Lit courses whose credit may be applied to more than one requirement - (Art 434 Required for degree.)

Before being formally admitted to the B.F.A. program, candidates must:

Complete 15 hours of core courses with a GPA of 3.0;
Pass Sophomore Portfolio Review — a portfolio presentation and critique that demonstrates seriousness of interest and adequate skills;

Submit a completed BFA application form; and
Receive a letter from the department Chair approving continuation of work toward the B.F.A. degree. To remain in this program, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA in art.

UL: — Select an Upper Level course. 45 UL hours are needed to graduate. i.e. a course number above 3000. Note that primary and secondary concentration courses must be carefully selected so as to meet the 45 UL hour graduation requirement.
